



Numerous youth programs in the region offer residents the opportunity to cheer their sons and daughters on in games of soccer, baseball, football, lacrosse and field hockey.

From Southern Virginia, it's an easy drive to enjoy professional sports with the Carolina Panthers and Carolina Hurricanes or to participate in a college rivalry at a Virginia Tech, UVA, UNC or Duke football or basketball game.



There are 6 public school systems and 7 private schools within Southern Virginia. Each school system is fully accredited and boasts high educational attainment rates for their students. We're also home to 8 Higher Educational Institutions, and more than 40 Colleges and Universities are located within a 50-mile radius. Regional Governor's Schools give advanced students academic opportunities beyond those normally available in the students' schools. The Southern Virginia region is gaining increasing attention for its innovative workforce training programs, many of which start with dual-enrollment opportunities in local high schools.

Through local initiatives like the Galileo Magnet High School in Danville, Martinsville's "STEM Pipeline," Halifax County's many "Academy" schools, and the Institute for Advanced Learning and Research's STEM Mobile Learning Lab, students in the region are offered intensive coursework in STEM-oriented curricula.

Graduates of area high schools have the choice of many high quality community college programs in the region, or they can choose from a multitude of public and private universities within an easy drive. Additionally, programs like the New College Institute and the Southern Virginia Higher Education Center allow the region's residents to pursue degrees from universities throughout the MidAtlantic region.

No matter where you choose to live, you'll enjoy housing costs 15-30% below the national average with very agreeable property tax rates. Additionally, the cost of healthcare, utilities and transportation averages 10-20% below the national average across the region.

Our cities and towns boast great historic homes on tree-lined streets while houses both modern and traditional can be found in the suburbs and in rural areas. You can even choose to live on the shores of one of our lakes or on a mountain ridge.

Efforts are underway to reinvent the downtown core of cities and towns in Southern Virginia. Add in access to residential fiber (internet, TV and phone) and walking trails and you can enjoy all the amenities of larger metropolitan areas for a fraction of the cost.
